Board Code of Ethics

Adopted by the Board of Directors February 11, 2014

As a member of the Washington Airport Management Association Board I will:

- 1. Represent the interests of all people served by this organization, and not favor special interests inside or outside of this Organization.
- 2. Not use my service on this Board for my own personal advantage or for the advantage of my friends or supporters.
- 3. Keep privileged information confidential.
- 4. Approach all Board issues with an open mind, prepared to make the best decisions for everyone involved.
- 5. Do nothing to violate the trust of those who elected or appointed me to the Board or of those we serve.
- 6. Focus my efforts on the mission of this Organization and not on my personal goals.
- 7. Never exercise authority as a WAMA Board member except when acting in a meeting with the full Board or as I am delegated by this Board.
- 8. In all matters before the Board, avoid actions that may lead to an actual or perceived conflict of interest. Disclose to the Board any matter that could give rise to a conflict of interest and accede to the determination of the Board regarding action to be taken to avoid the potential conflict.
- 9. Conduct all my Association activities without discrimination among individuals in violation of state/federal law or on the basis of personal characteristics other than ability, performance or documented qualifications.
